- It shall be his/her primary duty to set an example in citizenship, to be dynamic leaders when required and to be ideal followers when desire.
- Safety and Security of student should be given high priority by the teacher. Teacher must build one to one relationship with students Teacher must be good at planning , Preparation , Presentation , Evaluation, Giving feedbacks , Diagnosis , Remediation and Enrichment
- Diary is a sort of record of his/her day-to-day activities. It may show him/her what he/she has done, what he/she is doing and what he/she plans to do in the future. Schedules of the syllabus to be covered term-wise and month-wise etc. may be prepared in each subject he/she has to teach.
